#### Euro Medium Term Note Programme

This supplement (this Supplement) to the Base Prospectus dated 24th May 2018 (the Base Prospectus) constitutes a supplement for the purposes of article 13 of Chapter 1 of Part II of the Luxembourg Law on prospectuses dated 10th July 2005 (the Luxembourg Law) and is prepared in connection with the Euro Medium Term Note Programme (the Programme) established by Credit Suisse AG, acting through its Zurich head office or a designated branch (CS), and Credit Suisse Group AG (CSG, and together with CS, the Issuers and each an Issuer).
