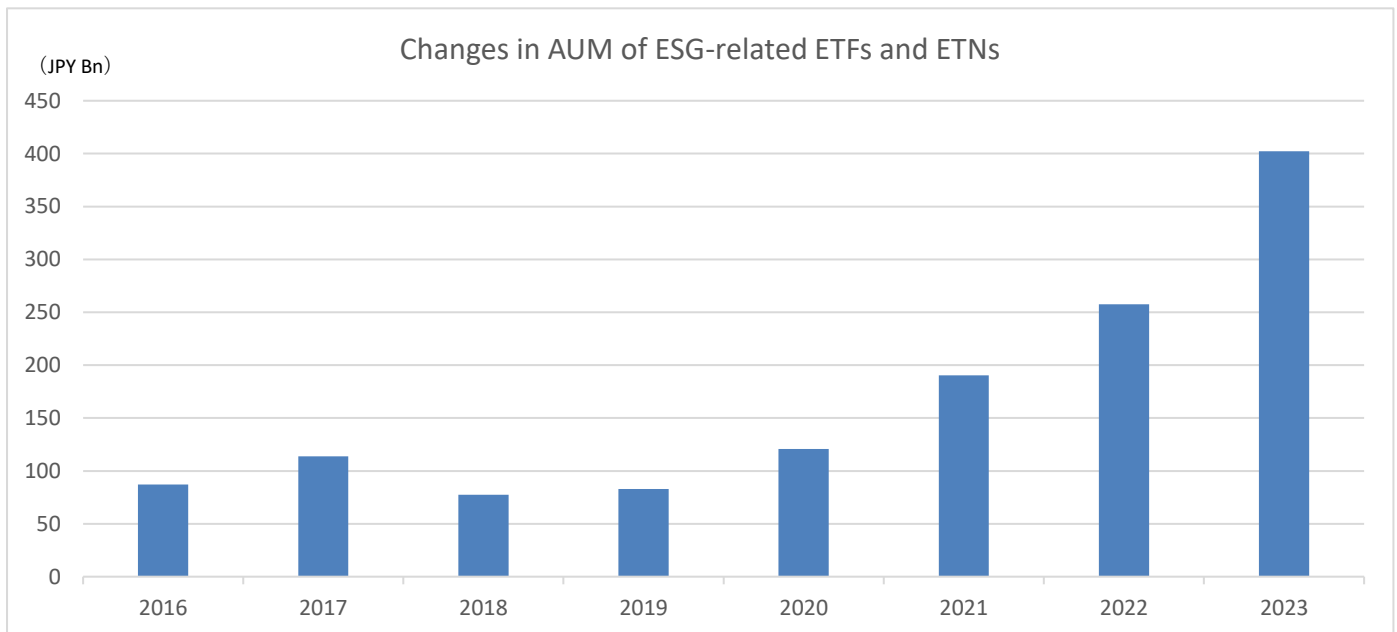

AUM of ESG-related ETFs and ETNs Exceeded JPY 400 billion

We are pleased to announce that AUM¹ of ESG-related ETFs and ETNs² listed on the Tokyo Stock Exchange (TSE) has exceeded JPY 400 billion.

The importance of ESG (Environmental, Social, and Governance) investment has been growing in recent years. Especially, interest in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), a set of 17 goals related to global economic, social, and environmental issues, has been proliferating globally. ESG investment through ETFs and ETNs has been attracting attention as an effective way of tackling these issues, and AUM of ESG-related ETFs and ETNs

listed on TSE has been steadily increasing.

The listed ETFs cover a wide range of assets, including equities, REITs, and bonds, and investors can utilize ETFs for ESG investments in various asset classes. In addition, expectations are higher than ever for newly listed ESG-related ETFs, such as the "iShares MSCI Japan Climate Change Action ETF" (Code: 2250, BlackRock Japan), which was listed on June 8, 2023 and reached AUM of over JPY 100 billion in three business days from the date of listing.

TSE will continue to enhance its lineup of ESG-related ETFs/ETNs and create an environment in which investors can take advantage of them, aiming to support the realization of a sustainable society through ESG investment.
