## Optimization of Increments of Bids and Offers in Stages

## I. Purpose

From the perspective of further increasing the convenience of the Japanese securities market, Tokyo Stock Exchange (hereafter referred to as "TSE") recognizes that there is a growing need for reducing the increments of bids and offers (hereafter referred to as "tick sizes") in auction trading pertaining to stocks (hereafter referred to as the "cash market trading").

Through implementing narrower tick sizes, TSE expects to bring investors the benefits of price improvements due to lower spread costs, which would likely be seen mainly for issues of high liquidity.

However, there are concerns that a market-wide revision to the tick sizes for all issues would cause the price discovery function to deteriorate for issues that are not sufficiently liquid, and that a sudden change would greatly impact market participants in terms of trading techniques, systems, and other aspects.

In light of such opinions, TSE plans to optimize, in stages, the tick sizes for cash market trading based on the liquidity and price of each issue.

Specifically, the revision will be implemented in three stages. First, in Phase I, the tick sizes at more than 3,000 yen will be revised for high-liquidity issues. This will be followed by Phase II where new sub-yen tick sizes will be introduced at 5,000 yen or less for such issues.

After these two phases, TSE will consider the effect of the revised tick sizes on trading conditions, etc., determine the scope of issues for which tick sizes should be revised, and implement a comprehensive optimization of tick sizes in Phase III.
